





1. Facility Ideas (11/34%)

- O **Update/Refresh Appearance (4):** Cosmetic upgrade to appear more inviting to kids and teens. | | Make the children 's section more appealing. | | There are a few areas of the library that I feel do need some help. Most notably, the area near the elevator in your basement. It's just unsightly! The walls look like they're moldy and dirty, and it doesn't even look like a place that we're supposed to be in, except it's how we need to get to your community room for programs and to use the restrooms (we have a stroller and can't use the stairs). Maybe a fresh coat of paint? | | Update the facility.
- Add Space Increase Size (2): A modern addition would be amazing. | | Just wondering if there is any effort to start a capital campaign to raise funds for a new library. The current one does not seem adequate in terms of location, space, light, etc.
- O Declutter/Organize (2): In the area near the elevator in your basement...the hallway itself seems to be a junk pile—I've seen trash bags, tables, stacked chairs, water jugs, and many other things piled up, and it just doesn't seem like the place they should be stored. I imagine that there's got to be a better place to keep all that stuff...My other issue in the building is your area for kids. It's a mess up there! Don't get me wrong, the people that work there are lovely, but the whole area is just so cramped and crowded. It's overwhelming! There's just so much stuff everywhere! | | Though I haven't been to the library in a couple of years, when I think of it from the past cluttered is what comes to mind. Perhaps a good overhaul and more organization would make it more appealing.
- O Misc. Unique Ideas (3): Better space for programs they are always excellent, and the little room downstairs is distracting with no doors and people wandering around | | I would love to see the beautiful architecture restored and preserved. | | Only really visited the children's area and would love to see more options for the younger kids (infant/toddler). Maybe even an activity area to help entertain while parents look at library materials

- O Misc. Unique Ideas (2): Host classes focused on areas of potential need such as babysitter classes, nutrition, health, wellness, exercise, beginners' computer, etc. | Multicultural programs, especially Spanish and Portuguese.

3. Collections Ideas (4/13%)

- O Add Books (3): I still love real books and hope they stay and are replenished as often as possible | | I would really like to see an investment into the expansion of eBooks and kindle audiobooks. Especially mysteries! | | It would also be nice to see more wholesome and classic books for teens.
- O Misc. Unique Idea (1): I'd love to see more home/garden/lawn games for the unusual collection.

- O Increase Hours (2): Just stay open as many hours as possible. | | Wish the library was open on Mondays.
- O Misc. Unique Ideas (2): Allow emotional support animals. | New director. Someone with people skills.

POSITIVE COMMENTS (8)


- "All in all, we love the library. My kids enjoy playing computer games and using train table and we all enjoy the programs you have. It's a great place for all! Thanks for all you do!"
